Dear Interested Party:

Thank you for your interest regarding the Permit to Install (PTI) applications from EES Coke Battery, LLC (EES Coke) located at 1300 Zug Island Road in River Rouge, Michigan; Dearborn Industrial Generation, LLC (DIG) located at 2400 Miller Road in Dearborn, Michigan; and United States Steel Corporation –Great Lakes Works (US Steel) located at 1 Quality Drive in Ecorse, Michigan and 1300 Zug Island in Detroit, Michigan. The three companies have submitted air permit applications (EES Coke: No. APP-2022-0290, DIG: APP-2023-0033, and US Steel: APP 2023-0066) to incorporate requirements from the Sulfur Dioxide (SO<sub>2</sub>) Federal Implementation Plan PTIs for various pieces of existing equipment located at their respective facilities. These actions are to address federal Clean Air Act requirements to bring the SO<sub>2</sub> nonattainment portion of Wayne County back into attainment.

Pursuant to state and federal requirements, EGLE held a public comment period that ended on August 28, 2023, on its proposed conditional approval of the permit. The Air Quality Division (AQD) did not receive any written comments during the public comment period.

After careful consideration of the issues and pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of EGLE, I have approved PTI Nos. 108-23 (EES Coke), 109-23 (DIG) and 110-23 (US Steel) with no modifications made to the proposed permits.
