This letter is in reference to your Permit to Install (PTI) application for sunroof manufacturing equipment located at 2700 Product Drive in Rochester Hills, Michigan (State Registration Number N1276). This application, identified as No. APP-2022-0267, has been evaluated and approved by the Air Quality Division (AQD), pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE). The approved PTI has been assigned No. 84-05B.

This approval is based upon and subject to compliance with all administrative rules promulgated pursuant to Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, and conditions stipulated in the enclosed supplement. Please review these conditions thoroughly so that you may take the actions necessary to ensure compliance with all of these conditions.

Please note, this facility is an existing opt-out source. This new permit continues to include the enforceable limits for hazardous air pollutants, which were previously accepted to restrict the facility's potential to emit to less than the major source threshold to opt out of the Renewable Operating Permit Program.

Additionally, a facility which obtains and operates under an active opt out permit is required to report to Michigan Air Emissions Reporting System (MAERS) and pay fees. The fee is dependent on the category of the source and emissions charge. Please see <u>AQD-013</u>: <u>Criteria Pollutant Threshold Levels for the Point Source Emissions Inventory</u> for further information, or you may contact your local district office for assistance.

Also, PTI Nos. 84-05 and 84-05A have been voided because the equipment is now covered by PTI No. 84-05B.
