

Two natural gas-fired boilers, each rated at 2.7 MMBTU/hr, have been in place in the Integral Stamping Assembly (ISA) Building at the Michigan Assembly Plant since 1989. These two boilers are exempt from permitting under Michigan Rule 282(2)(b), but have heat input capacities greater than the applicability threshold for Subpart DDDDD—National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Major Sources: Industrial, Commercial, and Institutional Boilers and Process Heaters.

These units were inadvertently omitted from the Title V permit. As such, Ford is proposing to add EU-ISAOFFICEBOILER1 and EU-OFFICEBOILER2 as emission units to the Title V permit. Descriptions for each unit should read as follows:

"Natural gas-fired heat boiler used to heat ISA Offices rated at 2.7 MMBTU/hr"

Both boilers should also be included as part of the Flexible Group FG-BOILERMACT.

Both units were installed in January 1989 and have not been modified in any way.

Under Subpart DDDDD, the natural gas-fired boilers would be subject to performing tune-ups, including a physical inspection of the burner, every five years. While not included in the Title V permit, Ford tuned these boilers and performed physical inspections of the burners annually. Emissions from these two boilers were included in the sitewide natural gas combustion emissions calculated annually.

Amended Initial Notifications have been submitted to U.S. EPA and EGLE. Appropriate deviations will be submitted as part of the next series of Subpart DDDDD and Title V reports due in January 2025 and March 2025, respectively.
