On behalf of Canton Renewables, LLC (Canton), Archaea Energy, Inc. (f/k/a Aria Energy, LLC), submits the enclosed minor modification application required by Rule 216(2).

On October 26, 2021, the State of Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) notified Canton that it had received a Permit to Install (PTI) application on October 14, 2021. On April 15, 2022, Canton was issued PTI No. 46-22 which authorized the installation of a nitrogen removal unit (NRU) and associated thermal recuperative oxidizer (TRO), the installation of hydrogen sulfide removal equipment, and reduced the permitted capacity of the open flare. Canton is submitting the enclosed minor modification application to incorporate the conditions of PTI 46-22 into its Renewal Operating Permit as required by Rule **216(2)**.
