**VIOLATION NOTICE**

On August 17, 2016, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Pro Weld, LLC located at 50625 Richard W Blvd, Chesterfield, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine the facility's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act, Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451), the administrative rules, and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 96-09.

During the inspection, AQD staff observed the following:

Process Description	Rule/Permit Condition Violated	Comments
Coating Spraybooth	PTI No. 96-09 special conditions EUPAINTLINE (VI)(1, 2, 3, & 4)	Facility did not keep coating use records and calculate monthly and 12 month rolling total VOC emissions records.
Facility-wide	PTI No. 96-09 special conditions FGFACILITY (VI)(1 & 2)	Facility did not keep records of individual and combined Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs) emissions based on 12 month rolling totals.

During this inspection, the company was unable to produce coating use, Volatile Organic Compound (VOC) and Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs) emission records. These are in violation of the recordkeeping requirements specified in PTI No. 96-09 special conditions EUPAINTLINE (VI)(1, 2, 3, & 4) and PTI No. 96-09 special conditions FGFACILITY (VI)(1 & 2) per the enclosed copy of PTI No. 96-09.


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Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by October 14, 2016 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If the company believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
