VIOLATION NOTICE

On May 29, 2014, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Johnson-Matthey Vehicle Testing & Development located at 12600 Universal Drive, Taylor, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules and the conditions of General Permit to Install (PTI) number 149-02I; 43-07; and 170-13.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Engine Testing	PTI # 149-02I (Conditions SC. I-VII); PTI # 43-07 (Conditions SC. I.1 –I.13); PTI # 170-13 Conditions SC. (II-VII)	Failure to produce emission records

During this inspection, Johnson-Matthey Vehicle Testing & Development was unable to produce emission records.

This is a violation of the recordkeeping and emission limitations specified in Special Condition number SC. I-VII of PTI number 149-02I; SC. I.1-1.13 of PTI # 43-07; and SC. II-VII of PTI# 170-13.

The conditions of PTI numbers 149-02I; 43-07; and 170-13 require maintenance of records, which shall be made available for review upon request by the AQD staff.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by July 21, 2014, which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter. The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are

proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Johnson-Matthey believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violation cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during my inspection of Johnson-Matthey Vehicle Testing & Development located at 12600 Universal Drive, Taylor, Michigan.
