VIOLATION NOTICE

On November 13, 2017, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), received information regarding the compliance status of Arvron Incorporated located at 4720 Clay Avenue SW, Grand Rapids, Michigan. A file review was conducted to determine Arvron Incorporated's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and Opt-out Permit to Install (PTI) No. 238-94B.

During the file review, staff observed the following:

Process Description	Rule/Permit Condition Violated	Comments
FG-EPS	Opt-out PTI No. 238-94B, Special Condition VII.1	Failure to notify AQD in a timely manner of completion of construction.
FG-EPS	Opt-out PTI No. 238-94B, Special Condition V.1	Failure to conduct VOC testing and destruction efficiency of the RTO within 180 days of commencement of trial operation.

Arvron Incorporated was required by Opt-out PTI No. 238-94B to test within 180 days of trial operation. Arvron Incorporated had not conducted stack testing of the RTO within the timeframe required in the permit. Additional file review found that Arvron Incorporated also did not notify the AQD of the completion of construction in the timeframe as required by Opt-out PTI No. 238-94B.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by December 28, 2017 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the


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dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Arvron Incorporated believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violations cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during my inspection of Arvron Incorporated.
