In response to violation with conditions and requirements of PTI No. 130-18 SC VI.2, Jackson Oven Supply was at our Facility on February 7th, 2024, to calibrate our thermocouples. Attached you will find a copy of the certification from February 7th. Elite has put in place a yearly appointment with Jackson Oven Supply to calibrate the thermocouples each year.

In response to violation with conditions and requirements of PTI No. 130-18 SC VI.3, regarding temperature data and records for the afterburner Elite has implemented procedural changes. Daily when the burn off oven process is started the operator is to verify that both pens are working properly, and if not, they are to get the Powder Coating Line Supervisor to take corrective action. The Powder Coating Line Supervisor is to inspect the temperature data recorder function once per shift. Each inspection will include verifying that both the red and green pens are recording properly and that the ink is dark enough to be seen. At the end of each work week all temperature data records will be collected, scanned into our network storage, and filed away.
