**VIOLATION NOTICE**

On March 13, 2020 and March 17, 2020, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Chemico Systems located at 50725 Richard West Boulevard, Chesterfield, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Chemico Systems' compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and to investigate a complaint which we received on March 11, 2020, regarding chlorine odors attributed to Chemico Systems operations.

During the investigation, staff discovered the following:

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by July 2, 2020 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
