Violation Notice Response**

Mr. Dunlap:

The purpose of this letter is to respond to your Violation Notice letter dated April 6, 2017. Prairie River Woodworking (PRW) has historically used manufacturer supplied coating formulation data to determine volatile organic compound (VOC) content for our compliance monitoring requirement purposes. During your April 4, 2017 Air Quality Division Inspection, you determined that PRW was in violation of Special Condition V.1 of FGBOOTH51-4, contained in RTI No. 30-14A. This Special Condition requires testing of coatings using federal Reference Test Method 24. Upon prior written approval, the VOC content may be determined from manufacturer's formulation data. PRW has prepared a written request for approval to use manufacturer's formulation data in our compliance monitoring program. This request was submitted to your office on April 14, 2017.

It is our hope that this request is approved and deemed adequate to comply with the Testing/sampling conditions contained in Special Condition V.1 of Permit to Install No. 30-14A. Please feel free to contact me with any questions pertaining to this authorization request.
