On November 1, 2018, I conducted an unannounced, scheduled inspection of Yanfeng Global Automotive Interiors (YFAI) in Lansing as part of a Full Compliance Evaluation. This facility was last inspected on January 9, 2017.

Facility Description and Regulatory Review:

YFAI (former JCIM) manufactured interior plastic parts for the automobile industry. Injection molding presses were used to produce the various types of interior automotive plastic parts. Adhesive was spray coated onto the plastic parts and vinyl skins attached for a finished part. A separate company, Intertec, used to operate the two (2) adhesive coating lines in the plant.

The interior plastic parts were for a wide variety of automotive vehicles. YFAI made the instrument panel (IP) dashboard for the Chevy Impala and Buick LaCross. Other plastic parts were made for the Chevy Volt, Nissan, Dodge, etc.

YFAI was located on the southwest side of Lansing. The area surrounding the plant is mixed use with industrial and commercial properties surrounding it.

YFAI was a minor source with a potential to emit of less than 250 tons per year (tpy) of any regulated air contaminant. The facility was considered a synthetic minor for emissions of hazardous air pollutants (HAPs) with opt-out limits of less than 9.0 tpy of any single HAP, and 22.5 tpy of aggregate HAPs. The facility had opted out of the Title V - Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) Program and any applicable federal standards with the permitted restrictions on emissions of HAPs. YFAI had one (1) active Permit to Install (PTI) No. 106-12B along with some exempt processes.

Commencement of Mfg. Operations: Spring of 2013

Plant Closed: December 2017

The facility is closed and the building for rent. I confirmed with Mr. Howie Frederick that the equipment has been removed and that PTI 106-12B could be voided.

I requested the permit void and the paperwork will be mailed to Howie. The facility will be closed in MACES at the beginning of the next fiscal year.
