Inspection Summary

I entered the school office where I met the receptionist Julee Holley and informed her of the purpose of my visit. Julee called Mark Scott and asked if would assist me. Mark and I met in the hallway. We walked to the boiler

room where we located the incinerator. It was obvious that the device had not been used for some time. Mark and I walked back to the office where I informed Julee that I would void the permit based on the device no longer being used. Julee provided me with Michael's information.

Although the incinerator was installed, I feel comfortable stating this device is no longer operational thus voiding the permit is acceptable.

This report will be used to void permit 179-681 in accordance with MDEQ memo Procedure for Voiding Permits to Install, dated June 7, 1999.

The following language will be included in the letter since the device is not entirely removed:

This permit is void based on the condition that although the incinerator is still installed, it is inoperable and no longer in use. Please be aware that future use of this device will require further permitting and trigger compliance requirements with one or more of the following federal regulations:
