On Friday, August 9, 2019, Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy-Air Quality Division (EGLE-AQD) staff, I, Adam Bognar, conducted a self-initiated inspection of Stellar Space-Age Materials located at 777 Baseline Road, Northville, MI 48167. The purpose of this inspection was to determine the facility's compliance status with the Federal Clean Air Act; Article II, Part 55, Air Pollution Control of Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 Public Act 451; and Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy-Air Quality Division (EGLE-AQD) rules.

According to AQD files, Stellar Space-Age Materials produced concrete and refractory (heat-resistant concrete products) materials at this location in the past. Dust generated from this process was controlled by several dust collectors. The last records of communication between AQD and the company was in 1999 when Stellar Space-Age Materials sent AQD a letter explaining the types of processing at the facility.

I arrived at this location at around 10 am.

The warehouse at this address is now occupied by Northville Lumber Company. I entered the facility and met with Mr. Stewart Oldford Jr. I identified myself, provided credentials, and stated the purpose of the inspection. I explained that there was previously AQD regulated equipment at this location.

Mr. Oldford showed me around the warehouse. Northville Lumber began leasing this warehouse several years ago. It is used as a bulk storage warehouse for a variety of lumber. Northville Lumber Company has operated at the property next to this warehouse for over 100 years. Mr. Oldford stated that Northville Lumber Company's claim to fame is that they are the oldest operating business in Michigan (established in 1827). There does not appear to be any AQD regulated equipment in this warehouse. The warehouse is used for storage only.

The AQD Stellar Space-Age Materials file will be archived as a result of this inspection.

Compliance Determination

Northville Lumber Company appears to be operating in compliance with the Federal Clean Air Act; Article II, Part 55, Air Pollution Control of Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 Public Act 451; and Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy-Air Quality Division (EGLE-AQD) rules.
