**VIOLATION NOTICE**

On March 15, 2017, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an investigation of the facility located at 11111 French Rd, Detroit, MI. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to our investigation, HRT Enterprises owns the facility and GRS Corporation purchased the rights to the steel at the site. MICH Scrap It and Mr. Peter Adamo performed the demolition activities at the facility. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the owners and operators equally liable for violations.

The industrial building at the site had previously been demolished and regulated asbestos containing materials (RACM) were identified, resulting in previous violations written to the owner/operators of the site. During the March 15, 2017 investigation, staff observed that the most recent 10 Day Notice of Intent to Renovate/Demolish for the removal of the debris had been canceled.



All parties please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by April 6, 2017 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If HRT Enterprises, GRS Corporation, MICH Scrap It and/or Mr. Peter Adamo believe the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
